The Town Council has set a budget which demonstrates its continuing commitment to supporting community events and continues to budget for the long-term benefit to residents.

Hedon Town Council set the precept for 2025-2026 at \pounds 286,000 a 10% increase from the previous year, which equates to a \pounds 11.53/year or 22p/week increase per Band D household per annum.
