1. Apologies for Absence

2. Confirmation of the Minutes of a meeting held on 10 February 2021
The Minutes of a meeting of the Emergency Planning Committee held on 10 February 2021 were agreed as being a correct record of the proceedings thereat.
Resolved: That the minutes were confirmed as a true record
3. Update on the Minutes
A reply from South Holderness Academy had not yet been received although an indication had been given that they would wish to be part of the Emergency Plan.
4. Declaration of Interests
 - 4.1 It was agreed that any declaration of interest be dealt with at the time the relevant item was discussed.
 - 4.2 There were no dispensations to be noted.
5. To consider action following ERYC reply to the request for a review of the Winter Salting Programme for Hedon
Members were disappointed at the reply which did not adequately answer the request for a review by the Council. The Town Clerk was asked to write again asking that a formal traffic count be undertaken on Inmans/Brevere Road (ERYC had not undertaken this since 2010). This survey should take into account the fact that the country is in lockdown which will severely affect the figures. Also, the request for a review included pavements which would not be included in a traffic count. Ivy Lane had been omitted from the original request and should be added.
6. To set a date for the Working Group to meet to put together a notice for website
The Working Group was open to all Members and was scheduled to take place at 3.30pm on Wednesday 7 April 2021 by remote access. Members were asked to forward suggestions for inclusion in the notice to the Town Clerk or Chairman prior to the meeting.

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7. Update re concerns raised in respect of the filling in of ditches/dykes around Hedon
A copy of the report following the 2007 floods, commissioned by the Town Council from Peter Kite was being looked for and this item would be on the next agenda for further discussion once it was known whether a copy could be located.
8. Update re meeting with the Environment Agency
Members noted that a list of questions had been sent to the EA to give the agency time to investigate the answers before the remote access meeting on 26 March (by remote access). An updated list of questions had been circulated.
