1. Apologies for Absence

3.2 Update Iveson car park – request for simpler sign and active enforcement sent to ERYC, response awaited. Members noted that the shrubs plant in the car park had been replaced with seasonal planting by ERYC.

3.4 MS3 community support – proposal that Hedon's food banks should be support was shared with MS3

3.5 Felling of trees in Merryman Garth – no communication, explanation or received to date from ERYC. The Clerk will write to ERYC to remind them that one of the felled trees was the subject of a TPO and it is an offence to fell without having taken appropriate action and must be replaced, and that the tree and land were the property of Hedon Town Council. In addition, ask that ERYC replace the trees in consultation with Hedon Town Council, one of which would be a Memory Tree.

5. To consider commemorating former Cllr and Honorary Freeman Neil
