1. Apologies for Absence  
Apologies were received from Cllrs: S Banks (illness), P Hinch (prior commitment) and D Storr (prior commitment)  
**Resolved:** that apologies were accepted
2. Confirmation of the Minutes  
The Minutes of the meeting of the Property Committee of the Hedon Town Council held on 11 July 2024 were agreed as being a correct record of the proceedings.  
**Resolved:** that the minutes were confirmed as a true record
3. Updates on the Minutes
  - 3.1 Update on ERYC funding for solar powered streetlights – unfortunately we don't think the project will fit with the high-street economic growth requirements of the funding we have available and that the funding outputs in particular would be hard to meet.
  - 3.2 Reminder of schedule for Heritage Weekend. All Cllrs on the schedule available, the Clerk will contact Cllr Goldspink to confirm.
4. Declaration of Interests
  - 4.1 It was agreed that any declaration of interest be dealt with at the time the relevant item was discussed.
  - 4.2 There were no dispensations to be noted
5. To ratify agreement to allow Yorkshire Water to install a Stone Path in Greville Road Playing Field  
**Resolved:** that the Council would ratify the decision to allow Yorkshire water to install a stone path in Greville Road Playing Field subject to maintenance of the path moving forward resting with Yorkshire Water
6. Update on the three trees felled by ERYC on Merryman Garth  
ERYC would replace the felled trees on Merryman Garth and ask Council what species of tree they would like to be planted. The trees felled were 2 no. hornbeam and 1 lime. Members agreed that the trees should be replaced like-for-like.  
**Resolved:** that the Council would request ERYC to replace the 3 trees like-for-like – 2 no. Hornbeam and 1 no. Lime
7. To consider provision of Parent-Toddler parking bays on Market Hill  
Members considered the proposal to allocate spaces on Market Hill specifically for Parent-Toddler parking. However, the areas lack of parking spaces would not be aided by widening two spaces at the expense of losing general parking spaces. On balance the number of parking bays should be preserved.

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**Resolved:** that the Council would reject the idea of providing allocated parking for parent-toddler parking on the grounds that it would reduce the number of parking spaces

8. To agree to the disposal or return of the removed stretchers from William Poultney painting

**Resolved:** that the Council would instruct the restoration company to dispose of the old stretchers.

9. To approve restoration work to the calligraphy of the Town Mayor list due to fading ink

**Resolved:** that the Council would proceed with restorative work to the calligraphy on the Town Mayor's list and the Clerk will write a letter of engagement.
