The Town Council has set a budget which takes into account imposed increases (eg Minimum Wage and pension contribution increases) and the cost of Town Council elections in May. The Town Council continues to budget for maintenance and repair of the town's assets which will be of long term benefit to residents.

Hedon Town Council set the precept for 2019-2020 at £213,990 which equates to an increase of £3.39 per Band D household per annum.
